Judging Criteria

Criteria	Description
Theme Interpretation	This criterion examines the extent to which the game effectively captures the essence of the retro arcade era, evoking nostalgia and paying homage to the classic arcade games of the past.
Gameplay Mechanics	This criterion evaluates the quality of the gameplay experience, assessing factors such as engagement, interactivity, intuitive controls, and the overall enjoyment and satisfaction derived from playing the game.
Innovation and Creativity	This criterion focuses on the game's originality, creativity, and the extent to which it introduces fresh and innovative elements within the retro arcade genre, demonstrating unique gameplay mechanics or features.
Visual Design and Graphics	This criterion assesses the visual aesthetics of the game, including the quality and appeal of pixel art or retro-inspired graphics. It considers how well the visuals align with the retro arcade theme and enhance the overall experience.
Sound and Audio	This criterion examines the effectiveness of sound effects and music in creating an immersive audio experience that captures the nostalgia and atmosphere of the retro arcade era.
Level Design and Progression	This criterion evaluates the quality of level design, assessing factors such as complexity, challenge, variety, and the overall progression system, ensuring a balanced and satisfying gameplay experience.
Fun Factor and Player Engagement	This criterion focuses on the game's ability to provide enjoyment and engage players. It assesses elements such as player motivation, replayability, and the overall entertainment value derived from playing the game.
Accessibility and User Experience	This criterion considers the game's accessibility and user-friendliness, examining factors such as adjustable difficulty levels, customizable controls, support for multiple platforms, and a positive user experience.
Technical Execution and Polishing	This criterion evaluates the technical aspects of the game, including stability, absence of major bugs or glitches, smooth performance, and the overall level of polish and attention to detail in its execution.
Professional Coding and Formatting	Assesses the technical aspects of the game, including coding practices, use of appropriate frameworks or engines, and adherence to industry standards. Evaluates the quality of code structure, organization, and readability. Also considers the overall game performance, optimization, and compatibility across platforms.
Business Opportunities	Considers the potential commercial viability of the game. Evaluates aspects such as marketability, target audience appeal, monetization strategies, and the overall potential for success in the gaming industry.
Overall Impression and Retro Appeal	This criterion encompasses the overall impact of the game, including its ability to evoke a strong sense of nostalgia, capture the essence of the retro arcade era, and leave a lasting impression on players and judges alike.
